MUT ZUR WUT 2014

International Poster Contest And Exhibition In Public Space

ABOUT THE CONTEST

For the 4th time the international contest gives creatives around the globe a chance to display an unfiltered and uncensored visual opinion with a critical, social, political, and/or personal content. "Mut zur Wut" aims to raise awareness for global and social issues and circumstances while loosening geographical and ideological boundaries.

Last year's contest inspired 980 creatives from 66 countries to participate.

The contest's popularity is in part, due to the fact that the submission process is completely free of charge and uncomplicated for the creator. The posters can simply be uploaded onto the contest's website: www.mutzurwut.de. The contest consciously abdicates conventional methods of presentation with expensive prints, complicated packaging and mailing fees. Thus, simplifying participation for crea-

tives, especially from censored countries.

The 30 most striking submissions will be displayed from June 23rd until July 23rd 2014 in public space and areas in different cities as well as in multiple exhibition.

THE SUBMISSION (MAX. 3 POSTERS PER PARTICIPANT)

The chosen theme should have a critical, social, political, and/or personal content, all of which should be illustrated in a striking poster

Posters may be uploaded from <u>March 15th</u> until <u>May 15th 2014</u> onto the contest's website: <u>www.mutzurwut.de</u>

Format:

.jpg with 150 dpi, DIN A3 (29.7 x 42cm). Uploaded images may not be larger than 3 MB.

Pleae note:

Once the 30 winnig posters are selected by the jury, we will ask for A1 (plus 3 mm four side trim) formats of your poster.

THE JURY:

In a two day meeting, the 5 internationaly noted members of the jury will review all submitted posters. The most significant 30 submissions will be nominated and produced for an exhibition, that will be put in various cities

Submission that have already been published as well as obvious plagiarisms will be eliminated from the contest

The selection will be from June 23rd until June 25th 2014 in Heidelberg, Germany.

RIGHTS:

The Artist hereby grants the non-royalty bearing transferable right to Mut zur Wut to use Works indefinitely for global publicati—on and unrestricted release. The Artist hereby accepts this grant of rights.

The rights granted under this agreement include the rights to exclusively use and exploit the Works, including without limitation, the right to copy the Works for the purpose of re-

presentation in the context of exhibitions in public spaces as well as in galleries, museums and the right to make the Works publicly accessible.

Insofar as the Artist's work under this agreement gives rise to neighboring rights or other rights, the provisions under this agreement shall apply accordingly to those rights.

The Artist also acknowledges expressly that the publication, copying and distribution of the Works from will be made in high qualities and might have a material public effect.
